The course began with a foray into the theoretical/mathematical basis for voting and democratic theory, but this was presented only partially and often in a way that was not connected to the rest of the course material. Either implementing a fuller exploration of voting and democratic theory, or leaving out some of the math, could perhaps make for a smoother syllabus.
Further, during the simulation, it could be helpful to increase the presence of rules and moderation of the debate. Sometimes students took what should have been an intellectual exercise a bit too seriously, and the debate environment became less than friendly. Stating the rules of engagement clearly could prevent ad hominem attacks in future classroom debates.






